Covid-19 is a new illness that can affect your lungs and airways. It is caused by a virus called Coronavirus. Symptoms can be mild, moderate, severe or fatal.

## What are the hazards?

## If an employee should fall ill

Anyone who either has a high temperature, a new persistent cough, loss of taste and/or smell or is within 14 days of the day when the first member of their household showed symptoms of Coronavirus (Covid-19) should not come into work, but must follow the guidance on self-isolation. A test must then be arranged.

## If someone falls ill at work

If a worker develops a high temperature, a persistent cough or loss of taste and/or smell whilst at work they should ensure their manager/supervisor is informed and go home immediately. A test must then be arranged.

They must then follow the guidance on self-isolation and not return to work until their period of self-isolation has been completed, or they have had a confirmed <u>NEGATIVE</u> test.

| If advised that a member of staff<br>or public has developed Covid-<br>19 and were recently on our<br>premises (including where a<br>member of staff has visited<br>other work place premises such<br>as domestic premises), the<br>management team of the<br>workplace will contact the Public<br>Health Authority to discuss the<br>case, identify people who have<br>been in contact with them and<br>will take advice on any actions or<br>precautions that should be<br>taken.<br>The NHS are now providing a<br>Test and Trace Service via app.<br>This is to ensure that anyone<br>who develops symptoms of<br>Coronavirus (COVID-19) can<br>quickly be tested to find out if<br>they have the virus. It also helps<br>trace close recent contacts of<br>anyone who tests positive for<br>Coronavirus and, if necessary,<br>notifies them that they must<br>self-isolate at home to stop the<br>spread of the virus.
